Motion by Ungrey, second by Noggle, to pay Novinty to install the camera at the cemetery. All ayes, motion carried.

Discussion on purchasing a podium for the hall.

Motion by Noggle, second by Ungrey to approve the Township Board Policy as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Noggle, second by Frantz to approve the Public Policy as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Rodarmer, second by Noggle to approve the revised dock ordinance in the Zoning Book. All ayes, motion carried. Discussion concerning the docks located on beaches. No action taken.

Rodarmer will check into having a public hearing to review the dock changes concerning the docks located at the beaches.

Motion by Ungrey, second by Frantz to open a credit card for the Township with the Clerk and Treasurer as signers. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Rodarmer, second by Ungrey, to approve the purchase of extraction equipment for the Firefighters. This money will come from the Capital Acquisition Fund. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Noggle, second by Rodarmer to appropriate the funds for the 2022-23 fiscal year for the Fire Department. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Rodarmer, second by Frantz to pay the bills with the addition of D&B Brine. All ayes, motion carried.
