Bill Dean from Newaygo marinas spoke about the dock situation on Diamond Lake. Wanted to know why some people are getting letters about illegal docks while others are not. Nerad stated just starting to enforce dock ordinances.

Joe Howes suggested we invoke the 5 minute rule as we have listened to dock issues for 2 1/2 years.
