Reports:

Zoning Administrator: Milan gave his report of permits issued and updated board upcoming Court dates.

Fire Board: D. Brown, Lincoln Township Fire Board Rep was present and gave report. Lincoln Township only had 2 fire runs from May 16 to June 16.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Stockwell gave report with previous months activity. Rodarmer motioned to accept, support by Bulson, all ayes, report was accepted.

Supervisors Report: DNR has approved an additional dock to be installed at the Boat Launch at Diamond Lake with a lift for Kayaks. The township cleanup day went well. Clerk Bulson reported that the cost was about a \$5000.00 savings from last year's cost by using different companies to dispose of garbage and scrap. The Memorial Day Service at the cemetery turned out great.

Assessors Report: Assessor Beach sent a written report of all assessment activities for the first quarter of this year. (Township Fiscal year is April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025.)

NCRC Road Report: There are plans to resurface 3 Mile the rest of the way to Foss.

Planning commission: A Workshop will be held on July 16, 2024 @ 6:00 PM the Township Zoning Master Plan. It will be held at the hall.

Stockwell motioned to accept the Planning Commission's recommendation to Amend the Lot Size / Setback Ordinance. Ungrey supported, all Ayes Motion passed

Megan Cruzan, White Cloud School Board member, spoke about the upcoming Millage Proposal for the school to update areas of all buildings, security updates and on an onsite Softball/Baseball complex. This would be an extension of the current millage with no increase.

Clerk Bulson made a motion to shut Township cell phone off and post her personal number on the web page and Facebook for TOWNSHIP CLERK business. It will save the township \$15.00 a month on phone charges. All department numbers are listed on the webpage. Supported by Rodarmer. All ayes, motioned passed.

Treasurer Stockwell made a motion to purchase a Portable Air Conditioner for the Township Hall. Frantz Supported, all ayes, motion passed. Clerk Bulson will get one from Menards and get it set up.
