

March 25, 2025, the Lincoln Township Special Meeting Budget was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Supervisor Robin Rodarmer. The purpose of this meeting was to give an oath of office to the new Planning Commission member, Rex Skupien and new Assessor, Kimberly Foster. Supervisor Rodarmer ask if there were any public comments or questions regarding the 2025 – 2026 Budget. There were none. The Budget meeting was closed at 7:00 pm.

March 25, 2025, the Lincoln Township Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Rodarmer at 7:02 pm. She led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Stockwell motioned to approve the minutes from February 20, 2025, meeting, Frantz supported the motion all ayes, minutes accepted. Agenda: Under New business 4 items we added to the agenda, Unfinished business 1 item was added. Rodarmer motion to accept the agenda with additions, support by Stockwell, all ayes motion accepted

REPORTS: Zoning Administrator gave out written reports and verbal, of the past months' activity.

Fire Board Report: from Donna Brown, Lincoln Township had zero fire runs last month. The Fire Department is putting together a meeting of the Supervisors and Clerks regarding possible upcoming millage.

Treasurers Report: lots of people showed up on the last Tax Day, extremely busy. Frantz motioned to accept Treasurers report, Support by Bulson, all ayes, motion accepted.

Supervisors Report: 6 people submitted petitions to the BOR, One Township at a Time group will be using the hall 2 times this week. Rodarmer is working on a quote to have a generator installed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Waterwood Farms: requested board to sign a Non-Profit paper for them, after much discussion regarding the business they do, a vote was taken, Yes: Rodarmer, Stockwell, Frantz No vote: Bulson Absent: Ungrey Rodarmer signed the requested form.

CONTRACTS: The Zoning Administrator and Assessor both signed their contracts for the 2025-2026 Fiscal year. Assistant Sexton, Josh Frantz, was given the contract for the Cemetery Sexton, Annie Trapp, to take home and sign and bring back at the next meeting.

PC – ask to have them go over the current Ordinances they are working on. We would like to get moving on those and possibly get them wrapped up. Asking for their first report by July.

Discussion on removal of old outhouses at the Township Beach, remove concrete, fill holes and topsoil, hire C Trapp to take care of this for \$2400.00. Motion by Bulson, support by Rodarmer

Jake Meyers from the Planning Commission is meeting with the ZBA Committee before the Planning Commission Meeting scheduled for April 10, 2025,

Steve Stickel is asking for a Combination of his lots, Milan Nerad, Zoning Admin. presented the documentation board agreed with his recommendation grant Stickels request.

Tenbrock ask Zoning Admin. And presented documentation to have his property line adjusted to support building a pole barn. Board agreed with Nerads recommendation to grant Tenbrock request.

Need to order new Stick Flags for Veteran graves, Clerk will get them ordered.

Stockwell motioned to sign the new required Retirement Fund Mers Resolution, Rodarmer supported, Roll call vote: YES- Rodarmer, Stockwell, Bulson, Frantz No-0 Absent - Ungrey

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

We received 3 Road bids from NCRC, some discussion was had on what we can afford this year. Board members should check these roads, we will discuss and decide which we can do in April.

Beach Sign: Creative Concepts submitted a bid for \$678.00 and the board approved that price.

New Township Flags were ordered from American Flag. Should arrive soon.

Discussion was had regarding adding wing sides to Veterans sign, we are out of room and have about 2 dozen names to add already. Supervisor Robin is working to make sure we have all of Lincoln Townships Veterans listed. Stockwell motion to approve up to \$1500.00 for 2 side panels to be added to the present sign, support by Frantz, all ayes, motion passed.

Regular Meeting was closed and Budget meeting opened at 8:12 pm

10 Resolutions were presented by Clerk Bulson: Meeting Dates, Budget, Road Fund, Fire Fund, Building Fund, Poverty Extension, Supervisors salary, Clerks Salary, Treasurers Salary, Trustees Salaries. All we accepted and approved by the board.

Budget Meeting was closed at 8:22 PM – Budget for Lincoln Township 2025-2026 Fiscal has been adopted.

Regular Board Meeting reopened at 8:23 PM – Correspondence None

Rodarmer motioned to pay the bills for March with 2 additions, Support by Stockwell. All ayes motion passed.

Stockwell motioned to pay any late arriving bills for the 2024-2025 fiscal year, support by Rodarmer, all ayes motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENT: A Resident asked that we not put gravel in the parking lot area at the Beach as it is very hard for the feet when little ones are walking barefoot.

BOARD COMMENTS: Stockwell ask that we not let last minute request ramp up stress on meeting days. Rodarmer motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 pm, support by Frantz, all ayes, meeting adjourned
