ORDINANCE NO.25-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LINCOLN

[The Planning Commission proposes to move the
Neighborhood Commercial Zone to a more suitable area]

THE TOWNSHIP OF LINCOLN (the "Township") ORDAINS:

Neighborhood Commercial

Neighborhood Commercial Zone location: Along the M-20 corridor between Baldwin heading west and ending at Croswell. The NC permitted zoning is not to exceed more than 640' south of M-20 or more than 1280' north of M-20. They must own at least 5 acres and have available 200' of frontage along M-20.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its publication or thirty (30) days after a summary of its provisions is published in the newspaper.
